

Worthy returns to camp

ST. JOSEPH, Mo. (AP) — The Kansas City Chiefs wide receiver Xavier Worthy returned to camp Friday, two days after he was placed in the concussion protocol. The second-year pro banged his head while trying to make a catch Tuesday during training camp at Missouri Western State University.

Worthy is expected to be a big part of the Kansas City offense after a dynamic rookie season in which he took advantage of the long injury absences of Marquise Brown and Rashee Rice to put up some big numbers. He finished with 59 catches for 638 yards and six touchdowns, then had 19 catches for 287 yards and three more scores in three playoff games.

Brown also missed practice Wednesday after hurting his ankle the previous day. So did fellow wide receiver Skyy Moore, who is dealing with a hamstring injury that could make it more difficult for him to make the team.

The Chiefs breezed through a quick workout Wednesday before getting Thursday off. They return for three more days of practice before another day off Monday. Those breaks could give some of their injured players,

including offensive lineman Jawaan Taylor (knee), an opportunity to recover ahead of their preseason opener on Aug. 9 in Chicago. Taylor also returned to practice Friday.

Chargers thrash Lions in HoF game

CANTON, Ohio (AP) — On his third team in his fifth season, Trey Lance played like a No. 3 overall pick.

Lance threw for 120 yards and two touchdowns Thursday night, and the Los Angeles Chargers beat the Detroit Lions 34-7 in the Hall of Fame game that kicked off the NFL's pre-season.

Jared Goff, Amon-Ra St. Brown, Jahmyr Gibbs, David Montgomery, Penei Sewell and the rest of Detroit's star-studded offense didn't see any action against Los Angeles.

The Chargers recovered a fumble on the opening kickoff at the Lions 28 and converted the short field into a 7-0 lead.

Lance made a perfect touch pass on fourth-and-2 to Will Dissly, who caught a 5-yard touchdown over a defender's outstretched hand.

After undrafted rookie cornerback Nikko Reed stepped in front of Kyle Allen's sideline pass and returned it 60 yards to the Lions 6, Kimani Vidal ran in from the 2 to make it 14-0.

Allen threw another pick on the next possession to Tony Jefferson.

Craig Reynolds' 3-yard TD run cut Detroit's deficit in half. But Lance fired a 19-yard pass to Tucker Fisk to the Lions 19 and connected with KeAndre Lambert-Smith on a 15-yard TD pass for a 21-7 halftime lead.

Try the impossible

South dealer.
North-South vulnerable.

The bidding:

South	West	North	East

Opening lead — four of clubs.

This deal occurred in a pairs tournament in New Jersey some years ago. After North-South reached four spades, West, at favorable vulnerability, elected to sacrifice in five diamonds.

South should probably have passed his partner's double of five diamonds, but he was reluctant to settle for plus 300 or 500 points (it would have been 500) when he felt there was a good chance to score 650 at five spades.

South regretted his decision as soon as he saw the dummy. To make

the contract, he would have to hold his losers to one heart and one club. This would apparently require a successful diamond finesse (virtually assured by the bidding), a successful spade finesse with East holding only two spades, and a 3-2 division of the opposing clubs.

Given West's ominous four-of-clubs lead, which looked like a sure singleton, South did not like his chances, but he plunged ahead bravely and found a way to make the contract. If you like solving problems of this sort, see if you can figure out how he did it before reading on.

Declarer took East's eight of clubs with the ace, led a diamond to the queen and returned a spade, finessing the queen after East followed low. South then cashed the ace of spades and king of clubs, confirming the bad news in the club suit, and led the three of spades to dummy's six. The ace of diamonds was then cashed, declarer discarding a club, and the seven of diamonds was led. But instead of ruffing, South discarded his remaining club!

This sequence of plays left West without recourse. He had to return a heart — allowing South to score a trick with the king — or a diamond, allowing South to discard a heart as he ruffed in dummy. Either way, the improbable game was home.
