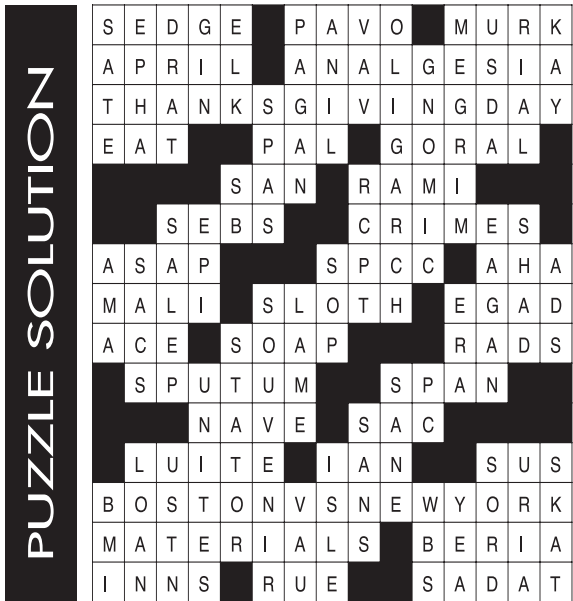

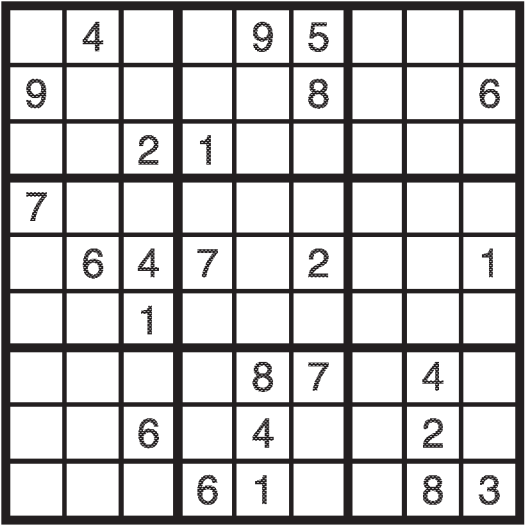

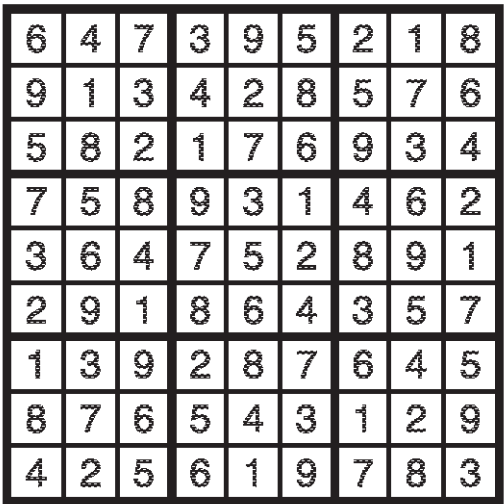
SUDOKU
