WHEREAS, the County Seat Bar & Grill has requested to host a beer garden serving alcoholic liquor and/ or cereal malt beverage during Boom-

WHEREAS, the County Seat Bar & Grill has requested a temporary extension of its licensed premises to include the baseball field located on South Douglas Avenue, directly across from Serra Street; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 41-1201(e)(1) permits the issuance of a temporary permit for the consumption of alcoholic liquor on public property, provided such event has been approved by the governing body of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Lyons, Kansas, desires to approve the County Seat Bar & Grill's request to host a beer garden and to temporarily allow the sale, possession, and consumption of alcoholic liquor and/or cereal malt beverage on the baseball field located between South Douglas Avenue and Meadowlark Street, directly across from Serra Street, as designated in the diagram

3. All alcohol service must comply with state and local licensing require-4. The permit holder shall indem-

nify and hold harmless the City of Lyons from any liability arising from the event and shall provide proof of insurance if requested. SECTION 4:

This Resolution shall be published once in the official city newspaper as required by law.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication.
