Racing in the Varsity boys division, Harlan Panchost came in 6th place with 6 laps and Isaac Palen finished in 8th also with 6 laps. The Raptor's JV boys competing

were, Colton Jeardoe placing 6th and Luke Hollerich in 8th, both with five laps. Conner Sumpter finished in 8th place in the Sophomore boys race with 3 laps. Parker Williams led the Freshmen boys by placing 7th (4 laps), Brodey Schreiber 16th (4 laps), Luke Hartsock in 17th (4 laps) and Zane Betzold in 19th (3 laps).
