Beloit's Samantha Thompson hit a seventh-inning game-winning home run.

Nickerson played Beloit riding a 21-game losing streak. Beloit (19-8) meets Minneapolis (20-4) for a 3A state softball berth.

Panther pitcher Mayci Terhune struck out 10 batters to nearly overcome 10 walks. Terhune walked four batters in Beloit's tying 3-run sixth inning.

In the first, Jayli Groth scored on a Shalie Powell's single and Lakyn Brown scored on Taylor Huggard's single.
