Sterling is larger than it was in 1940—by two dozen souls—according to federal census reports released this week. Government representatives give the town a population of 2,239, as compared with the 1940 figure of 2,215. The county total is placed at 15,593, a sizeable drop from the 1940 census figure of 17,213. Other federal counts for Rice county towns are Alden 287, Chase 953, Geneseo 655, Little River 636 and Lyons 4,540.
