NOTICE OF SCHOOL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2018, and any amendments thereto, that a General School Election to elect three (3) board members will be conducted in Unified School District No. 494, Hamilton County, State of Kansas, on the 4th day of November, 2025.

This district has the “election at large method” of election, which means election of board members without member districts. There will be three (3) board members elected. Each board member will be elected for a four (4) year term beginning on the 2nd Monday of January, 2026. Each person shall be a qualified elector of the at large district of which he or she files as a candidate.

Candidates for such offices shall file in the office of the County Clerk of Hamilton County, Kansas. Every such filing shall be made before noon, June 2, 2025. Each such filing shall be accompanied by a filing fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or by a petition signed by not less than fifty (50) electors residing in the “at large” school district, or by a number of such electors equal to not less than ten percent (10%) of the electors residing in the “at large” district, whichever is less. No candidate shall be permitted to withdraw his or her candidacy after the last date provided by law for filing such candidacy.

Notice is further given that if there are more than three (3) times the number of candidates as there are members to be elected, the County Election Officer shall call, and there shall be held, a Primary Election on Tuesday, the 5th day of August, 2025. The names of twice the number of candidates as there are members to be elected who received the greatest number of votes at the Primary Election shall appear on the ballots in the General Election.

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2107, and any amendments thereto, that a General City Election to elect three (3) City of Syracuse Council Members, one (1) City of Coolidge Mayor, and five (5) City of Coolidge Council Members will be conducted in, Hamilton County, State of Kansas, on the 4th day of November, 2025.

Each City of Syracuse Council Member will be elected for a four (4) year term beginning on the 2nd Monday of January, 2026. The City of Coolidge Mayor and each City of Coolidge Council Members will be elected for a two (2) year term beginning on the 2nd Monday of January, 2026. Each person shall be a qualified elector of the member district of which he or she files as a candidate.

Candidates for such offices shall file in the office of the County Clerk of Hamilton County, Kansas. Every such filing shall be made before noon, June 2, 2025. Each such filing shall be accompanied by a filing fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).

Notice is further given that if there are more than three times the number of candidates as there are members to be elected, the County Election Officer shall call, and there shall be held, a Primary Election on Tuesday, the 5th day of August, 2025. The names of twice the number of candidates as there are members to be elected who received the greatest number of votes at the Primary Election shall appear on the ballots in the General Election.
