July was wetter than normal

For many places around Kansas, the month of July was wetter than normal.

At Eisenhower National Airport in Wichita, the National Weather Service reported 4.54 inches of rain, which was .56 inches above average. For January through July, Wichita has received 28.22 inches of precipitation, which is 6.69 inches above average. That makes this year the 10th wettest on record dating back to 1888, and the wettest since 2008.

In July, El Dorado received 8.65 inches of rain, which is 4.23 inches ahead of average. Newton

had 6 inches of rain, and Kingman saw 5.97 inches. Both totals are close to 2 inches above average.

For the year, Sedan has recorded 38.84 inches of precipitation, which is more than 13 inches above average and the third wettest year on record.

Temperatures were above, below and close to average. The warmest day in Wichita was 97 degrees on July 30. The coolest temperature was 64 degrees on July 2.

Most notably, Wichita had not seen a high of 100 degrees or hotter through July 31. This is the first time that has happened since 2007.

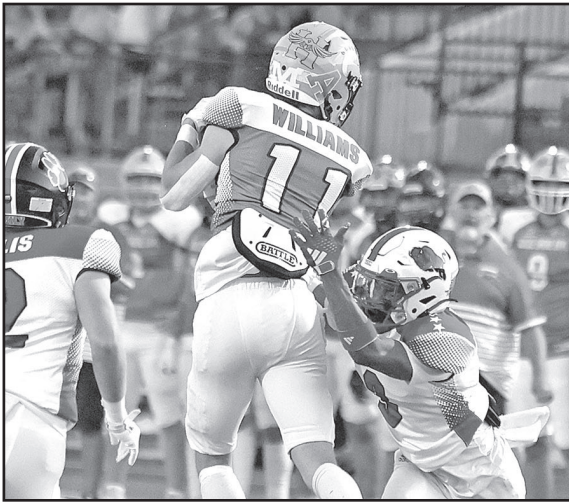
