USD 248 School Board Meeting - June

▶▶ The USD 248 Board of Education gathered for their monthly board meeting Thursday, June 12th at the USD 248 Board Office.

Following the pledge of allegiance the meeting was called into session.

The board accepted three donations that included \$2,700 from the Hospital Foundation for HOSA National Competitions, \$500 from Hospital District #1 for HOSA National Competitions and \$1,000 from the Girard Lions Club for the RVH backpack program.

They then approved the USD 248 Mentoring Program. The program is intended to prepare and support new teachers in the district.

They authorized the superintendent and board clerk to make all legal and appropriate transfers from the 2025-26 budget to any special revenue funds and approved the 2025-26 GHS and RVH student handbooks, the 2025-26 student ipad/technology policies, the 2025-26 USD 248 general facility use agreement, the 2025-26 activity center use policy and the 2025-26 Red Wutke sports complex user policy.

They appointed Superintendent Todd Ferguson as a representative to the Southeast Kansas Career and Technical Center of Crawford County (CTEC) Board of Directors.

Ferguson updated the board on the district's facilities. The tiles in the Family and Consumer Sciences class have been removed as part of the classroom's renovation. Spouts have been replaced at the high school. A safe room is being installed at RVH. The RVH gymnasium is being repainted. New carpet is being installed at the Early Education Center.

Following an executive session for non-elected personnel, the board accepted the resignation of Ariana Faucett as an RVH preschool instructor and the employment recommendation of Machia Davenport as an RVH Kindergarten instructor.

They then approved technology purchases for the 2025-26 school year. Generation 11 i-pads will be distributed to the teaching staff and several i-macs are being replaced in classrooms for the upcoming school year.

The board approved a bid for facility/auto insurance and entered into the Kics Pool.

They also approved curriculum purchases for GMS science and GMS and RVH mathematics.

Following updates on the Interlocal school and Greenbush, the meeting was adjourned.
