NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND OF ISSUANCE OF TAXABLE INDUSTRIAL REVENUE BONDS

Public notice is hereby given that the City Commission of the City of Goodland, Kansas (the "Issuer"), will conduct a public hearing on June 15, 2026 at 5:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard in the Commission Room at City Hall, 204 West 11th Street, Goodland, Kansas 67735 in regard to the issuance by the Issuer of its Taxable Industrial Revenue Bonds (Bread Boy), in a principal amount of approximately \$225,000,000 (the "Bonds") and in regard to an exemption from ad valorem taxation of property constructed or purchased with the proceeds of such Bonds. The Bonds are proposed to be issued by the Issuer under authority of K.S.A. 12-1740 et seq., as amended, to pay the costs of the acquisition, construction and equipping of a flour mill, bakery and wheat delivery system facility (the "Project") to be located in the industrial park on the west side of the Issuer. The Issuer further intends to lease such facility to Golden Waves Grain, LLC, a Kansas limited liability company (the "Tenant"), or its assigns, or another legal entity to be formed by the principals of the Tenant. The governing body of the Issuer will not pass an ordinance authorizing the issuance of such revenue bonds until the public hearing has been concluded.

Notice is further given, in accordance with K.S.A. 12-1744e, that the Issuer intends to issue the Bonds and lease the facility to the Tenant as set out above.

A copy of this Notice, together with a copy of the inducement resolution of the Issuer adopted on May 18, 2026, indicating the intent of the governing body of the Issuer to issue such Bonds and a report analyzing the costs and benefits of such property tax exemption, are on file in the office of the Clerk, or will be as soon as completed, and available for public inspection during normal business hours.

All persons having an interest in this matter will be given an opportunity to be heard at the time and place above specified.

State of Kansas Notice Concerning Proposed Kansas Air Quality Class I Operating Permit Renewal

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is soliciting comments regarding a proposed air quality operating permit. Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline Inc. - Levant Compressor Station has applied for a Class I operating permit renewal in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-510 et al. The purpose of a Class I permit is to identify the sources and types of regulated air pollutants emitted from the facility; the emission limitations, standards and requirements applicable to each source; and the monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting requirements applicable to each source as of the effective date of permit issuance.

Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline Inc. - Levant Compressor Station, 4700 State Route 56, Owensboro, Kentucky 42301 owns and operates a natural gas compressor station located at Section 24, Township 5S, Range 35W, Colby, Rawlins County, Kansas 67701.
