

# Labette County FFA Chapter brings home big awards from State Convention

From Labette County FFA

Congratulations to the Labette County Future Farmers of America Chapter for their outstanding performance at the 2026 State FFA Convention. Labette County High School featured numerous members throughout each session of this statewide event in both competitive and service activities, and the performance of our members was spectacular.

Three members of the Labette County FFA Chapter were selected to participate in the State FFA Chorus. Emma Carter, Jonathan Dusher, and Ady Gatton rehearsed all week and performed alongside their peers from numerous high schools from across our great state. They performed multiple times on stage and were featured in the State Chorus Concert. We would like to thank Mrs. Terrell for preparing our students for success and supporting them in their FFA endeavors.

The second session of the Kansas FFA State Convention was highlighted by Labette County FFA members winning multiple awards. In the SAE Grant Ceremony, Charles Black, Ady Gatton, and Caleb Merrick were each awarded \$500 State SAE Grants for their Supervised Agricultural Experience Programs. Meanwhile, Lily Wiley was awarded a National SAE Grant of \$1,000 for her program. However, the session was not finished, as McKynlee Baker, Alex Dolechek, Gavin Foster, Taylor Gudde, and Cooper Newby were each honored as State Proficiency Award Finalists. At the end of the day, Taylor Gudde was featured as the State Proficiency Award Winner in the area of Beef Production Placement. She will receive \$250 for her efforts and will represent Kansas at the national level in October as she competes with the best beef production programs from across the nation.

The third session featured proficiency award finalists Abby Dolechek, Jaci Falkenstien, Jaya Fiscus, and Cashlee Smith. When results were read, Jaci Falkenstien was recognized as the State Champion in the area of Goat Production. Jaci will receive \$250 for her efforts and will represent Kansas at the national level in October as she competes with the best goat production programs from across the nation. However, the third session was not done; Cooper Newby was also honored as a CTE Scholar to conclude this session.

The fourth session was highlighted by the announcement that Taylor Gudde was named the State Champion in the Extemporaneous Public Speaking Leadership Development Event. Taylor will receive \$100 for her efforts and will represent the Sunflower State at the National Extemporaneous Public Speaking LDE in October.

The fifth session was impressive for the Labette County FFA Chapter as numerous members were awarded scholarships

from the National FFA Organization; these scholarships totaled \$37,000. Those recognized were: Jaci Falkenstien, \$2,000; Sierra Hill, \$10,000; Cooper Newby, \$2,000; Lucy Pearson, \$2,000; Alexis Spencer, \$5,000; Teige Thiesing, \$5,000; Tylee Trollope, \$1,000; Pyper White, \$5,000, and Lily Wiley, \$5,000. This was an amazing accomplishment for an outstanding group of students from Labette County High School.

However, the fifth session was not completed. Two teams from the Labette County FFA Chapter were recognized for dominating the competition and earning first place honors in their particular events. The Ag Sales team featured overall high individual Jaci Falkenstien, second place individual Lucy Pearson, third place individual Sierra Hill, and Ainslynn Green. Each member of this team will receive \$250 for their efforts and will represent Kansas at the National Ag Sales CDE, which will be held at the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana, this October. Finally, the Labette County FFA Entomology team was recognized as the state champion as team members Sierra Hill placed fourth, McKynlee Baker placed seventh, Jaci Falkenstien placed 10th, and Lily Wiley completed the team.

Like their counterparts in the Ag Sales CDE, the Entomology team members each earned a \$250 travel stipend to represent Kansas at the National Entomology CDE, which will be held on the campus of Tarleton State University in Stephenville, Texas later this year. All in all, the

competitive teams from Labette County High School did their part to continue the tradition of success that the chapter is known for.

Finally, the delegates from the Labette County FFA Chapter voted for the new state officers as they participated in numerous activities and interacted with one another. Casting the vote for the Labette County FFA Chapter and serving as Chapter Delegates were Jay Alloway and Charles Black. Their service to the chapter and to the state association was greatly appreciated.
